

## Grounds Maintenance Programme

Location: Westham, Pevensey, East Sussex

Duration: 3 years

Client: Westham Parish Council

PJ Chaffin have recently been awarded a contract to manage the land owned by Westham Parish Council.

The Parish grounds consist of 8 hectares of grassed areas, hedge boundaries, fence lines, pathways, playing fields and a small pond.

The works comprise of grass cutting, shrubbery and small plant preservation, controlling overhanging branches and brambles, managing the ingress of vegetation, pruning shrubs, hedge cutting and shaping, strimming under tree lines and around relevant obstacles, weed spraying, the clearance of pathways, and general upkeep of the grounds.

Working with the Parish Council to maintain open areas and parks, the contract consists of 12 visits per season. Staff liaise regularly with the public allowing them to express their thoughts on maintenance and upkeep. These ideas and thoughts are relayed to Council representatives and often form the basis for future management plans.
